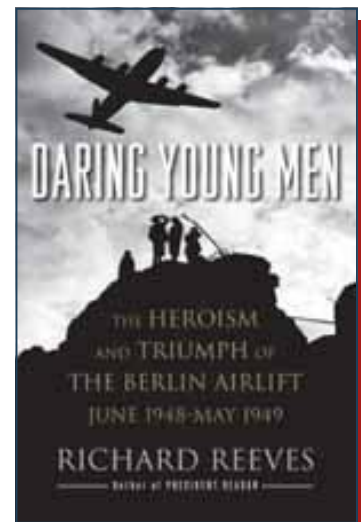

RICHARD REEVES is Senior Lecturer at the Annenberg School for Communication at the University of Southern California and a widely published author and syndicated columnist since 1979. He was Chief Political Correspondent of *The New York Times* and National Editor for *Esquire* and *New York Magazine*. He has been a Pulitzer Prize finalist and juror. His *President Kennedy: Profile of Power* was named the Best Non-Fiction Book of 1993 by *Time* and Book of the Year by *Washington Monthly* and is now considered the authoritative work on the 35th president. He has also written best-selling biographies of Presidents Nixon and Reagan as well as a study of President Bill Clinton.
